What does it mean to be a Sponsoring Stake of Brighton Girl's Camp?

- *Annual Stake Assessment fee (currently \$400 due in early February each year).*
- *Guaranteed reservation space for the 12 year old Beehives in your stake.*
- *Decreased registration fee per camper (2019 fees = \$125 vs. \$150 for public).*
- *Opportunity for meaningful service. Stakes provide 8-10 women and 8-10 men as scheduled every 2 ½ years to assist with the opening or closing (winterizing) of camp.*
- *Participation in our registration process. A representative of the Stake YW leadership attends the Registration Training in February, and oversees the registration needs of all campers in your stake.*

- *Opportunities for Eagle Scout projects for your stake Young Men.*
- *Great employment opportunity for 16 to 17 year old YW in the kitchen.*
